## The Office des changes strengthen its information and facilitation measures on the occasion of the AFCON 2025

**O**n the occasion of the Africa Cup of Nations (AFCON 2025), the Office des Changes is setting up a reinforced system to support foreign fans and Moroccans living abroad (MRE) throughout their stay in Morocco.

This system aims to simplify currency exchange operations, enhance transparency, and ensure optimal access to information as soon as visitors arrive in the country.

In this context, the Office des Changes issued Circular No. 3/2025, which introduces easing measures allowing foreign exchange operators to carry out currency exchange transactions via international bank cards, thus providing more convenience and comfort for visitors.

In order to ensure clear, accessible communication that meets the needs of visitors, the Office des Changes has deployed several information tools, including:

- A dedicated page on the Office des Changes website, gathering all essential information regarding currency exchange facilities during the AFCON 2025;
- A trilingual video clip (Arabic-French-English), broadcasted in the main airports of the Kingdom, explaining in a simple and visual way the rules for declaring foreign currency and best practices for currency exchange.
- Printed brochures distributed at airports, designed to provide visitors with a practical guide upon their arrival.

Through this comprehensive system, the Office des Changes reaffirms its commitment to supporting the success of the 2025 Africa Cup of Nations, to maintaining the quality of the Kingdom's hospitality, and to ensuring a smooth experience that meets current standards for all visitors.
