### **Signing of a framework partnership agreement between the Office des Changes and the National Council of Chartered Accountants**

*The* Office des Changes held a meeting on February 24, 2026 in Casablanca with the National Council of Chartered Accountants of Morocco, dedicated to presenting and discussing the main provisions of the General Instructions on Foreign Exchange Transactions 2026 (IGOC 2026).

*This* meeting is part of the ongoing dialogue and consultation process adopted by the Office des Changes with its institutional partners and key actors in the national economic ecosystem. It provided a valuable opportunity to present the developments introduced by IGOC 2026 including the new structure of the text, the streamlining and facilitation measures, and the procedures for implementing these provisions.

*The* discussions also focused on the mechanisms established to support economic operators, as well as the central role of chartered accountants in understanding and effectively applying foreign exchange regulations.

*At* the conclusion of this meeting, the two institutions signed a partnership agreement establishing a formal framework for cooperation and exchange.

*Signed* by the Director of the Office des Changes, Mr. Driss BENCHIKH, and the President of the National Council of Chartered Accountants, Mr. Faiçal MEKOUAR, the agreement provides for the development of joint training activities and capacity-building programs in areas of common interest, collaboration on economic and financial studies and research, and the joint organization of awareness campaigns and professional events.

*The* signing of this agreement reflects the commitment of the Office des Changes to institutional dialogue, the sharing of expertise and the support of professionals in the service of the economic development of the Kingdom.
