As part of the upcoming deployment of the Unified Foreign Exchange Platform, the Office des Changes has initiated, since 14 April 2026, an extensive training program for all foreign exchange companies.

These regional roadshows, organized according to a schedule covering the entire national territory, aim to prepare foreign exchange operators for the use of the new platform and ensure a smooth and effective adoption of its functionalities.

The Unified Foreign Exchange Platform is an integrated solution designed to enable the digital, real-time, and secure management of foreign exchange transactions. It provides professionals with a modern and efficient environment that meets the highest standards of speed, traceability, and regulatory compliance.

This new system includes several advanced features, notably the centralization of operator data, the real-time transmission of transactions to the Office des Changes, as well as a dedicated module for Anti-Money Laundering and Combating the Financing of Terrorism (AML/CFT). In addition, the platform offers information-sharing capabilities and reporting tools that support the generation of statistical analyses for informed decision-making.

This support and proximity-driven approach reflects the commitment of the Office des Changes to assisting foreign exchange operators in their transition toward a structured, modern, and fully dematerialized management environment.
